
WHAT WE BELIEVE

All songs are carefully curated to help prepare our hearts for worship and correlate with the messages we hear.



BAPTISM AT FBC

Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. Romans 6:3-4 ESV







WHY DO WE BAPTIZE?

Not only did Jesus command it, but when we are baptized, we are following Christ's example.

"At that time, Jesus came from Nazareth and was baptized by John in the river." Mark 1:9

WHAT DOES BAPTISM MEAN?

It is a symbol of Christ's burial and resurrection, AND it is a symbol of your new life as a Christian.

"...Christ died for our sins...He was buried...He was raised on the third day..." 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

WHO NEEDS TO BE BAPTIZED?

Every person who has made the decision to surrender his or her life to Christ.

"Those who believed and accepted His message were baptized." Acts 2:41

HOW ARE WE BAPTIZED?

Like Jesus, we are immersed in water.

"As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water." Matthew 3:16

WHEN ARE WE BAPTIZED?

As soon as you have believed!

"Those who believed...were baptized...that day!" Acts 2:41

WHAT WE BELIEVE

We are a Southern Baptist Church, and we affirm the Baptist Faith and Message. You may view the full document on our website at fbccumming.org. The following are statements summarizing core beliefs essential to our faith and non-negotiable for our doctrine.

ABOUT GOD:

God is the creator and ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed in three persons - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and are one God.

ABOUT THE BIBLE:

The Bible is God's word to all men. It was written by human authors, under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living. Inspired by God, it is truth without any mixture of error.

ABOUT HUMAN BEINGS:

Human beings are made in the image of God and were meant to be like Him. They are the supreme object of God's creation. Although people have tremendous potential for good, they are marred by an attitude of disobedience toward God called sin. This innate rebellious attitude separates mankind from God. Through Christ, this image or ability to reflect God can be restored.

ABOUT ETERNITY:

Man was created to exist forever. He will either exist eternally separated from God by sin or in union with God through forgiveness and salvation. To be eternally separated from God is hell. To be eternally in union with Him is eternal life. Heaven and hell are places of physical, conscious, eternal existence.

ABOUT JESUS CHRIST:

Jesus Christ is the son of God. He is co-equal with the Father. Jesus lived a sinless human life and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all men by dying on a cross. He arose from the dead after three days to demonstrate His power over sin and death. He ascended to Heaven's glory and will return again to earth to reign as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

ABOUT SALVATION:

Salvation is a gift from God to man. Man can never make up for his sin by self-improvement or good works - but only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith.

WHAT WE BELIEVE

ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT:

The Holy Spirit is equal with the Father and the Son of God. He is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ. He also lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation. He provides the Christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. The Christian seeks to live under His control daily.

ABOUT BAPTISM:

Baptism by immersion symbolizes the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus and is your public declaration that you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior. Baptism does not save you, but shows the world that you have already been saved. And while baptism is not required for salvation, it is a biblical command and demonstrates your love and obedience to Christ.

ABOUT COMMUNION:

Communion, or the Lord's Supper, is an ordinance given to all believers by Jesus Christ to remember His sacrifice for us and to symbolize the new covenant. The elements of bread and wine or juice are symbols of Christ's broken body and shed blood. Communion is not a means of salvation. Rather, it is a testament of Jesus Christ's atoning work of the cross.

ABOUT RESURRECTION:

We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into Heaven, and in His present life there for us, as High Priest and Advocate. Moreover, because of Jesus Christ's atoning work on the cross, there will be a bodily resurrection of the just and unjust. Those whose Lord is Christ will be raised and saved to experience everlasting life (Heaven); and those whose Lord is not Christ will be raised and condemned to everlasting separation from God (hell).

ABOUT THE CHURCH:

We believe that the New Testament church is a local body of baptized believers with Christ as its head and the Holy Spirit as its guide. New Testament churches promote God's work by cooperating together for missions and many other joint efforts. The local church is autonomous and to be governed independently of outside persons, bodies, groups, or authorities. The New Testament also teaches that there is also a universal Church, the body of Christ that is made up of Christians both dead and alive - the redeemed of all the ages, believers from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.
